1. Policing (PC Ellen Beatty, Warwickshire Police)

The following three priorities were agreed for the Safer Neighbourhoods Team:

1. Parking at Packington Lane (St. Edwards School)
2. Parking on Church Lane, Old Arley
3. Speeding on Tamworth Road, Corley

PC Beatty reported there had been a 'spike' in domestic burglaries around Maxtoke – but this looks to have settled down.

2. New school

Progress around the development of the new Arley Primary School was reported.

It was requested that footpaths and verges are returned to their former condition when the work is complete.

The issue of a village traffic plan for Arley was raised. Colin Hayfield suggested this could be revisited in due course.

3. Big Local (Gill Hutchinson)

Gill Hutchinson presented an overview of the 'Big Local' Scheme for Arley and Ansley.

4. Questions and Issues From the Parishes

Traffic Issues

A number of issues were raised around the volume and speed of traffic, and it was agreed to invite County Highways to the meeting on 3rd July.

Recycling Scheme

Some teething troubles with the new system were noted.

Dog Mess Bins

Arley Parish Council requested clarification as to who provides dog mess bins, and who is responsible for them.

Development Proposals

Proposals for 800 new houses around Tamworth Road near Corley was discussed. Although this falls within Coventry, it borders on the Area Forum South area. Do WCC or NWBC have a view regarding the development?
