2. Notes and Matters Arising of the meeting held on 5th February 2013

Notes of the previous meeting were agreed

3. Police Update

PCSO Udall presented the Safer Neighbourhoods Team update. The following comments were made:

- No noticeable change in crime or fear of crime reported since part-time street lighting came into effect across the county. WCC is monitoring the effects of the switch. WCC to look at lighting for Manor Road, Mancetter
- Atherstone: parking around Market Street, HGVs using the archway at the top of Market Square.
- Number of HGVs passing through Mancetter
- Off road motorbikes: St George Road & Royal Meadow Drive, Atherstone
- Domehawk camera effective above entrance to Hartshill Hayes although motorcyclists now using entrance behind cemetery.
- Carlyon Road Industrial estate: staggered deliveries by Balfour Beatty, Sandwich factory, Autoquip and others has made a huge difference to traffic flow

Three priorities chosen:

Priority: ASB around Market Square and St Mary's church, Atherstone

Priority: HGV & speeding – Ridgelane, nr Atherstone

Priority: Off road motorbikes – Hartshill Hayes, Cemetery, The Woodlands, Hartshill

4. West Coast Power Supply Improvements @ Atherstone station

T McLoughlin and J Logan informed of 9 new sub-stations being installed between Wembley and Crew, including sites at Nuneaton and Atherstone. Further information was given about the work schedule for the Atherstone site off Minions Close.

Details were given of a Sustainability Action Plan to help engage with communities. Two projects were considered: a roof over the ticket machine at Atherstone station and improvements to the local play area off Minions Close.
